

Northern Gem & Northern Treasure Ash

Botanical name: *Fraxinus x 'Northern Treasure/Gem'*

Origin: Two hybrid ash recently introduced by the Mor-den Research Station of Agriculture Canada.

Hardiness: Zone 2 (Canadian and USDA)

Growth Rate: Medium to fast growing, growg at a rate similar to Patmore Ash. Mature height: 40-50 feet.

Description: Northern Treasure is a vigorous grower with an upright growth habit and tends to retain a strong central leader. Northern Gem combines vigor-ous growth with a broad to oval form. The fall colour is a uniform yellow-orange colour.

Landscape Value: Excellent shade tree for residential, boulevard and commercial plantings. The outstanding foliage, upright growth habit and symmetrical branch-ing makes it a premier choice for tree planting.



Prairie Spire® Ash

Botanical name: *Fraxinus pennsylvanica 'Rugby'*

Origin: A seedless ash selected by Dr. Dale Herman at North Dakota State University.

Hardiness: Zone 2 (Canadian and USDA)

Growth Rate: Medium to fast. Mature height: 50-60 feet.

Description: Selected for its superior hardiness and survival in adverse prairie conditions. Glossy, deep green foliage. Bright golden yellow fall colour.

Landscape Value: Excellent in residential, downtown and parkway plantings. The narrow upright growth is ideal for urban street tree use.



Ivory Silk Tree Lilac

Botanical name: *Syringa reticulata 'Ivory Silk'*

Origin: Selected at Sheridan Nursery in Ontario for its sturdy, more compact, oval growth habit compared to Japanese Tree Lilac.

Hardiness: Zone 3 (Canadian and USDA)

Growth Rate: Moderate grower. Mature height: 15-20 feet.

Description: A small tree with cherry-like bark, glossy foliage and spectacular creamy white, fragrant flowers that bloom in late June. No disease or insect problems.

Landscape Value: Excellent as an accent tree in resi-dential and recreational areas. The outstanding foli-age, fragrant flowers and symmetrical branching make this a good choice for park and residential plantings.



Northern Blaze® White Ash

Botanical name: *Fraxinus americana 'Jeffnor'*

Origin: A Jeffries Nurseries introduction. Discovered by Dr. Wilbert Ronald in an open-pollinated seedling population of a northern Minnesota source.

Hardiness: Zone 2 (Canadian and USDA)

Growth Rate: A vigorous growth rate that compares to Patmore Ash. Mature height: 40-50 feet.

Description: Outstanding dark green foliage turns purple in fall. The growth habit is an upright oval shape during the juvenile stage, developing into an open, round-topped crown at maturity. New twig growth is dark purple. Fall colour in shades of maroon.

Landscape Value: Excellent shade tree in residential, downtown and commercial plantings, where out-standing foliage is desired.



Goldrush® Cherry

Botanical name: *Prunus x 'Jefree'*

Origin: Goldrush is an open-pollinated seedling of a Amur Cherry. This cultivar possesses traits of Pin Cherry suggesting hybridization in its parentage. Se-lected for improved resistance to frost cracking.

Hardiness: Zone 2 (Canadian and USDA)

Growth Rate: Medium to fast. Mature height: 20-30 ft.

Description: A small tree with golden, exfoliating bark that provides excellent winter effect. White flowers are followed by black fruit that attract birds in mid-summer.

Landscape Value: Excellent as an accent tree in resi-dential and recreational areas. The outstanding orna-mental features make this cultivar a premier choice for a park and residential plantings.



Golden Cascade Linden

Botanical name: *Tilia cordata 'Golden Cascade'*

Origin: A Jeffries Nurseries introduction. Discovered by Dr. Wilbert Ronald in an open-pollinated seedling population of a Littleleaf Linden from a Manchurian source.

Hardiness: Zone 3 (Canadian and USDA)

Growth Rate: Medium, similar to other Littleleaf Lin-den cultivars. Mature height: 35-50 feet.

Description: A medium sized tree with a globe-shaped crown and cascading branches. The leaves are medium sized and consistently turn a golden yellow colour in the fall. Resistance to sunscald.

Landscape Value: Excellent as a shade tree displaying a cascading crown form for large spaces in residential and recreational areas.



Harvest Gold® Linden

Botanical name: *Tilia mongolica* 'Harvest Gold'

Origin: A Jeffries Nurseries introduction. Discovered in an open-pollinated seedling population produced by crossing Littleleaf Linden from a Manchurian source with a Mongolian Linden.

Hardiness: Zone 2 (Canadian and USDA)

Growth Rate: Approximately 10-15% less than Littleleaf Linden. Mature height: 35-45 feet.

Description: Upright growth habit. Exfoliating bark. Attractive, disease-free, glossy foliage that consistently turns a golden fall colour.

Landscape Value: Excellent shade tree in residential and downtown plantings, particularly where an upright growth habit and reduced spread are required.



Silver Cloud® Maple

Botanical name: *Acer saccharinum* 'Silver Cloud'

Origin: Selected from an open-pollinated seedling population of a Silver Maple (Skinner Source). Introduced by Jeffries Nurseries and Prairie Shade Nursery.

Hardiness: Zone 3 (Canadian and USDA)

Growth Rate: Medium to fast. Mature height: 60-70 ft.

Description: A hardy Silver Maple selected for its upright crown, central leader, symmetrical branching and reduced basal sprouting. Golden yellow fall colour.

Landscape Value: Excellent in residential and parkway plantings. A good choice for larger spaces.



Norlin® Linden

Botanical name: *Tilia cordata* 'Ronald'

Origin: A Jeffries Nurseries introduction. Selected by Dr. Wilbert Ronald from an open-pollinated seedling population from a Manchurian source.

Hardiness: Zone 3 (Canadian and USDA)

Growth Rate: Approximately 10-15% faster than Littleleaf Linden. Mature height: 35-50 feet.

Description: A hardy hybrid of Littleleaf Linden selected for its rapid growth and improved resistance to leaf spot, leaf gall and sunscald. Shiny, moderate sized, heart-shaped, green leaves.

Landscape Value: Excellent shade tree in residential and downtown plantings, particularly where faster growth and a broad, pyramidal crown are required.

Unity® Sugar Maple

Botanical name: *Acer saccharum* 'Jefcan'

Origin: Selected from a fourth generation seedling population of hardy Sugar Maple. Introduced by Jeffries Nurseries in 2002.

Hardiness: Zone 3 (Canadian and USDA)

Growth Rate: Medium growth rate. Mature height: 30-40 feet.

Description: A Sugar Maple selected for its hardiness, upright crown and central leader. Yellow-orange fall colour. Resistant to frost cracking and tip kill.

Landscape Value: Excellent in residential plantings. Collector tree with many ornamental features.
