Botanical Name:	<i>Monarda didyma</i> 'Coral Reef'
Family:	<i>aceae</i>
Common Name:	Coral Reef [®] Monarda
Hardiness:	Zone 3 (Canadian and USDA)
Description:	The plant grows up to 90 cm in height and 60 cm wide and is more compact than Marshall's Delight. Loaded with deep pink flowers from July to September.
Culture:	Grows best in full sunlight or partial shade. Prefers well drained, medium textured soils with adequate moisture.
Pest and Disease:	Coral Reef [®] is hardy and has good resistance to powdery mildew.
Landscape Value:	Excellent new perennial with unquestionable hardiness. Deep pink flowers attract butterflies and hummingbirds to the garden. Useful as a cut flower.
Propagation:	Softwood cuttings or divisions.
Production:	Propagation by licensed growers only. Royalty of 20 cents per plant.
