Grand Marshall[®] is a new introduction from the Morden Research Station that complements their recent Monarda releases. This exciting new perennial produces an abundance of bright, fuchsia-purple flowers that attract bees and butterflies to the garden.

Grand Parade[®] and Grand Marshall[®] are the newest Monarda from Agriculture and Agri Food Canada. They represent the latest and best of the Morden mid-sized germplasm.

Botanical Name: *Monarda didyma* 'AChall'

Family: *Lamiaceae*

Common Name: Grand Marshall[®] Monarda

Hardiness: Zone 3 (Canadian and USDA)

Description: The plant grows up to 50 cm in height and 60 cm wide and is slightly more open than Grand Parade[®]. Loaded with fuchsia purple flowers from July to September.

Culture: Grows best in full sunlight or partial shade. Prefers well drained, medium textured soils with adequate moisture.

Pest and Disease: Grand Marshall[®] has good resistance to powdery mildew.

Landscape Value: Excellent new perennial with unquestionable hardiness. Fuchsia purple flowers attract butterflies and hummingbirds to the garden. Useful as a cut flower.

Propagation: Herbaceous cuttings or divisions.

Production: Propagation by licensed growers only. Royalty of 20 cents per plant.
