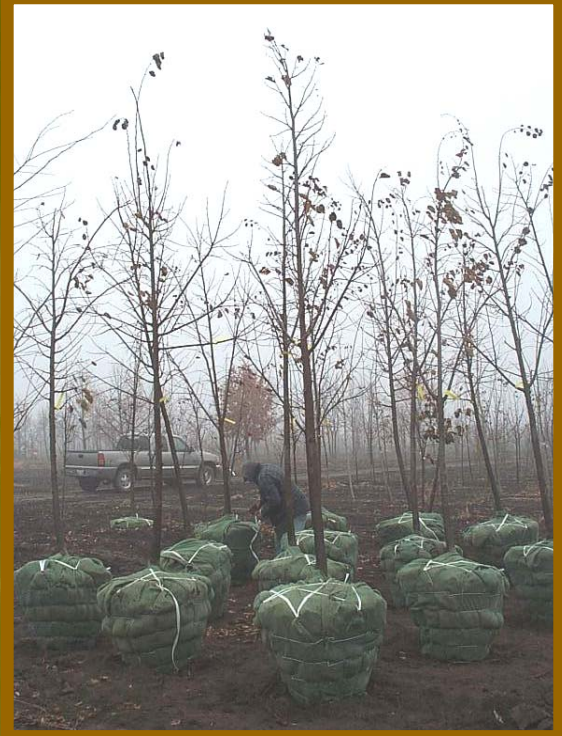

Tilia cordata 'Ronald'

A hardy Littleleaf Linden hybrid selected for rapid growth, resistance to leaf spot, good resistance to leaf gall and resistance to sunscald.

Botanical Name: *Tilia cordata* 'Ronald'

Family: *Tiliaceae*

Common Name: Norlin[®] Linden

Origin: Open pollinated seedling of a Littleleaf Linden from a Manchurian source. Developed by Dr. Wilbert Ronald of Jeffries Nurseries Ltd.

Hardiness: Zone 3 (Canadian and USDA). Rated as top grower in state tests in N.D.

Growth Rate: Approximately 10-15% faster than typical Littleleaf Linden.

Description: A hardy hybrid of Littleleaf Linden selected for its rapid growth, resistance to leaf spot, good resistance to leaf gall and improved resistance to sunscald. Shiny heart-shaped, green leaves. Mature height is 35-50 feet.

Culture: Grows best in full sunlight to partial shade in well drained, medium textured soils with adequate moisture.

Pest and Disease: High resistance to leaf gall, leaf spot and sun scald.

Landscape Value: Excellent shade tree in residential and downtown plantings, particularly where aster growth and a broad, pyramidal crown are required.

Propagation: Budding on Littleleaf Linden.

Sales Potential: Norlin[®] Linden is an excellent choice in areas where a medium-sized Linden with increased cold hardiness is required.

Production: Propagation by licensed growers only. Canadian Plant Breeders Rights and U.S. Plant Patent #8,239. COPF Royalty of 50 cents per plant.
