A male selection of large tooth aspen with an upright crown form, clean foliage and consistent and attractive fall colour.

Botanical Name:	<i>Populus grandidentata</i> 'Durman'
Family:	<i>Salicaceae</i>
Common Name:	Sabre [®] Aspen
Origin:	A clonal selection from a native population growing in Eastern Manitoba.. Introduced by Rick Durand of Portage la Prairie, MB.
Hardiness:	Zone 2 (Canadian and USDA)
Growth Rate:	Medium
Mature Size:	12 metres (40') in height and 5 metres (15') in width
Description:	Sabre [®] Aspen is a male selection of large tooth aspen that has attractive coarsely toothed green leaves that emerge as a velvety purple/red colour, clear, smooth bark and an upright crown form. Sabre [®] consistently displays a golden yellow fall colour.
Culture:	Sabre [®] grows best in rich and well drained soils and in full sun. Some chlorosis occurs in high alkaline soils (similar to Swedish Aspen).
Pest and Disease:	Good resistance to pests, medium-high tolerance to shoot blight.
Propagation:	Tissue culture.
Sales:	Sabre [®] Aspen is suited in large spaces such as parks and in multiple plantings for a natural forest look since it requires low maintenance.
Production:	Propagation by licensed growers only. COPF royalty of 50 cents.
